Purchase Adds Up to MathWorks Campus

The MathWorks is purchasing an office building for \$30.8 million in the same Natick complex as the company's headquarters, solidifying a plan to create a campus, according to the MetroWest Daily News.

The engineering software company already owns two buildings on the site, and the company made plans to buy the office building, called Apple Hill 1, based on being able to construct a fourth building on the site. As the Boston Business Journal reported earlier this month, The MathWorks' expansion plans have been in the works for five years.
